ORDER

By this Order, the commission finds that the revised tariff sheets and rate schedules filed by YOUNG BROTHERS, LIMITED ("Young Brothers") on October 16, 2007, comply with the tariff and rate changes authorized by the commission in Decision and Order No. 23714, filed on October 12, 2007. Accordingly, the revised tariff sheets and rate schedules shall take effect upon the issuance of this Order.¹

I.

Background

By Decision and Order No. 23714, the commission approved an increase in intrastate freight revenues of \$4,391,105, or approximately 7.51 percent over intrastate revenues at present rates, for Young Brothers, based on a rate of

return of 10.76 percent and a total intrastate revenue requirement of \$68,893,418 for the 2007 calendar test year. In so doing, the commission approved the Stipulation on Settlement of All Issues in This Proceeding jointly filed by the Parties on July 20, 2007, as further supported by the Joint Supplement to Stipulation on Settlement of All Issues in this Proceeding of Young Brothers, Limited and the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Attachments A - B, jointly filed by the Parties on September 19, 2007.

Specifically, the commission approved: (1) rate increases in the container, straight-load racks, automobiles, and less than container load cargo categories, at various percentages; (2) the implementation of a fuel price adjustment clause, commonly known as a fuel surcharge; and (3) other changes to Young Brothers' tariff.

By Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Decision and Order No. 23714, the commission instructed Young Brothers as follows:

No later than October 22, 2007, Young Brothers shall file its revised tariff sheets and rate schedules for the commission's review and approval, with copies served upon the Consumer Advocate. Said filing, which is intended to implement the increases in rates and charges and other tariff changes authorized by Section II of this Decision and Order, shall not take effect without the commission's affirmative approval.

Decision and Order No. 23714, Ordering Paragraph No. 3, at 76.

On October 16, 2007, Young Brothers filed its revised tariff sheets and rate schedules for the commission's review and

approval.² By its filing, "Young Brothers certifies that the tariff sheets have been accurately revised to reflect the Commission's directives in Decision and Order No. 23714."³ In addition, Young Brothers requests that the commission approve the revised tariff sheets and rate schedules as soon as possible.

II.

Discussion

Based on Young Brothers' certification and the commission's independent review, the commission finds that the revised tariff sheets and rate schedules filed by Young Brothers comply with the tariff and rate changes authorized by the commission in Decision and Order No. 23714. Accordingly, the revised tariff sheets and rate schedules shall take effect upon the issuance of this Order.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Young Brothers' revised tariff sheets and rate schedules shall take effect upon the issuance of this Order. Young Brothers shall promptly file copies of its approved tariff sheets and rate schedules, with the applicable issued and effective dates.


2. Unless ordered otherwise by the commission, upon the filing of the approved tariff sheets and rate schedules, this docket shall be closed.


