By this Order, the commission grants KAUAI ISLAND UTILITY COOPERATIVE's ("KIUC") Motion to Withdraw Its Application Without Prejudice, filed on October 26, 2007.

Withdrawal of Application

On August 27, 2007, KIUC filed an application for commission approval to commit funds to undertake the construction and completion of the Hanahanapuni Substation Project ("Project"), pursuant to Section 2.3.g.2 of the commission's General Order No. 7, <u>Standards for Electric Utility Service in</u> <u>the State of Hawaii</u>.¹ On October 26, 2007, KIUC filed a Motion to Withdraw Its Application Without Prejudice in which it

states that it "has decided not to proceed with the [Project] as it believes that the implementation of the [P]roject is not imperative at this time and that there may be other more feasible alternatives available to accomplish the benefits and objectives that this [P]roject was designed to achieve."²

The commission approves KIUC's withdrawal of its Application without prejudice, and closes this docket.
