<u>ORDER</u>

By this Order, the commission closes this docket.¹

I.

Background

This proceeding arises out the commission's investigation and evaluation of competitive bidding as a mechanism for acquiring or building new generation capacity in the State of Hawaii ("State").²

On June 30, 2006, the commission issued Decision and Order No. 22588, which set forth a proposed Framework for

Competitive Bidding, for the Parties' review and comment.³ Following the commission's review of the comments submitted by the Parties, the commission, on December 8, 2006, issued Decision and Order No. 23121 in which it adopted a Framework for Competitive Bidding as a mechanism for acquiring or building new energy generation in the State ("CB Framework").⁴ Specifically, the CB Framework outlines a comprehensive mechanism for the electric utilities to acquire a future generation resource or a block of generation resources under the competitive bidding process.

On March 14, 2007, the commission granted KIUC's Motion for Exemption from the CB Framework, pursuant to Part II.A.5 of the CB Framework.⁵

For purposes of implementing the CB Framework, the commission: (1) on June 22, 2007, approved the list of qualified candidates for the Independent Observer position submitted by the HECO Companies;⁶ (2) on August 28, 2007, approved the Code of Conduct Pertaining to the Implementation of a Competitive Bidding Process for New Power Supplies submitted by the HECO Companies;⁷ and (3) on November 5, 2007, approved the proposed tariffs for

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interconnection and transmission upgrades submitted by the HECO Companies.[®]

II.

Discussion

On October 9, 2007, the commission opened <u>In re Public</u> <u>Util. Comm'n</u>, Docket No. 2007-0331, "to receive filings, review approval requests, and resolve disputes, if necessary, related to HECO's proposal to proceed with a competitive bidding process to acquire approximately 100 [megawatts] of non-firm renewable energy for the Island of Oahu."⁹ In Docket No. 2007-0331, the commission indicated its intent to close Docket No. 03-0372, "[0]nce the remaining issue in that docket related to [the] approval of [the HECO Companies'] interconnection and transmission tariffs is resolved[.]"¹⁰

On November 5, 2007, the commission issued Decision and Order No. 23799, its final, remaining decision to implement the CB Framework and the competitive bidding process in general. The deadline for filing a Motion to Reconsider Decision and Order No. 23799 was November 19, 2007, with no such motions filed. Accordingly, the commission hereby closes Docket No. 03-0372.
