ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE NO. 5178-C

By this Order, the commission revokes certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 5178-C ("Certificate No. 5178-C"), held by NELSON HIILEI HANOHANO, dba WAATEVERKONA ("Petitioner").

I.

Background

By Order No. 23388, filed on April 26, 2007, the commission placed Certificate No. 5178-C on inactive status for a period of one year, until May 17, 2008. In the order, the commission informed Petitioner that if Certificate No. 5178-C was not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., by May 17, 2008, the commission would deem it to be abandoned and revoked, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-19(b).

Findings and Conclusions

Certificate No. 5178-C was not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., by May 17, 2008. We, thus, find that there is good cause to revoke Certificate No. 5178-C.





1. Certificate No. 5178-C is revoked.
