address any customer service or service quality complaints received by the commission; a map showing the areas in which it is designated an ETC; an informational tariff incorporating the rates, terms, and conditions for its Lifeline service offering and its Link Up discounts; and its detailed advertising plan for the provision of the core services, including the content and manner of its planned advertisements, and the targeted consumers.<sup>2</sup>

On May 12, 2008, Applicants timely filed the required information, in accordance with Decision and Order No. 24169. Having complied with the commission's directive, the commission closes this docket.
