ORDER APPROVING AMENDED STIPULATED REGULATORY SCHEDULE

By this Order, the commission approves, with modification, the Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule filed by the parties in this docket on June 3, 2008, attached hereto as Exhibit A.<sup>1</sup>

I.

Initiation of this Docket

By Order No. 23913, filed on December 20, 2007, the commission initiated this proceeding to examine the HECO Companies' proposal, in Docket No. 2007-0008,<sup>2</sup> for a

<sup>2</sup>In Docket No. 2007-0008 (RPS Docket), the commission is examining Hawaii's Renewable Portfolio Standards Law, codified in

Renewable Energy Infrastructure Program ("REI Program"). The REI Program includes, among other proposals: (1) a Renewable Energy Infrastructure Surcharge to ratepayers that would allow electric utilities in Hawaii to recover the costs of renewable energy infrastructure projects that facilitate third-party development of renewable energy resources, maintain existing renewable energy resources, and enhance energy choices for customers; and (2) a consolidation incentive mechanism that would allow the HECO Companies to recover costs for renewable energy infrastructure projects built in the County of Hawaii and/or the County of Maui through a sharing of costs between the neighbor islands and Oahu ratepayers. Although the HECO Companies proposed the REI Program in Docket No. 2007-0008, the Commission initiated this docket to separately examine whether the proposed REI Program is just and reasonable.

## II.

### Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule

On May 27, 2008, the Consumer Advocate, on behalf of itself, LOL, and HREA, requested approval for the Parties to file an amended regulatory schedule with the commission, by June 3, 2008, that would allow the Parties to receive and review the HECO Companies' estimated proposed customer surcharge, submit information requests and responses thereto, and submit statements

of position or direct testimonies.<sup>3</sup> By letter dated June 3, 2008, the commission approved this request.

On June 3, 2008, the Consumer Advocate, on behalf of itself, LOL, HREA, and KIUC, filed an Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule for this docket. By letter dated and filed on June 5, 2008, the HECO Companies informed the commission that it did not object to the Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule.

Upon review by the commission, the Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit A, appears reasonable. The commission therefore approves the Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule, but modifies it to include dates for the prehearing conference and evidentiary hearing. Unless otherwise ordered by the commission, the prehearing conference shall be held on November 12, 2008, and the evidentiary hearing shall be held on November 24, 2008 to November 25, 2008.

### III.

#### Order

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

The Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule, filed on June 3, 2008, and attached hereto as Exhibit A, is approved and shall govern procedural matters in this docket. However, the commission modifies the Amended Stipulated Regulatory Schedule by adding the following scheduled matters: (i) Prehearing

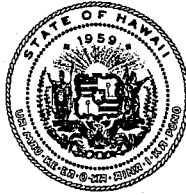

Limited's Proposal for a Renewable Energy Infrastructure Program.

On May 27, 2008, the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Consumer Advocate"), on behalf of the Consumer Advocate, Life of the Land ("LOL"), and Hawaii Renewable Energy Alliance ("HREA"),<sup>1</sup> wrote to request additional time to amend the regulatory schedule for this proceeding to provide the same parties with additional time to review the estimated proposed surcharge filed by the HECO Companies, request additional data or information about the HECO Companies' proposal, and file either statements of position or direct testimonies.

Attached for your consideration is an amended regulatory schedule agreed upon by the KIUC, LOL, HREA, and the Consumer Advocate. While we have not heard yet from the HECO Companies as to this amended regulatory schedule, we are reluctant to


