ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE NO. 4012-C

By this Order, the commission revokes certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 4012-C ("Certificate No. 4012-C"), held by MAUI TRUCKING, INC. ("Petitioner").

I.

Background

By Order No. 23645, filed on September 10, 2007, the commission placed Certificate No. 4012-C on inactive status for a period of one year, from September 10, 2007 to September 9, 2008. In the order, the commission informed Petitioner that if Certificate No. 4012-C was not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., by September 9, 2008, the commission would deem it to be abandoned and revoked, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-19(b).

Findings and Conclusions

Certificate No. 4012-C was not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., by September 9, 2008. We, thus, find that there is good cause to revoke Certificate No. 4012-C.

Order


THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

2. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.




