By this Order, the commission dismisses the application filed by KAPA'A TRUCKING, INC. ("Applicant") on March 24, 2008, as amended on April 28, 2008, and closes this docket.

I.

Application to Extend Common Carrier Authority

By application filed on March 24, 2008, and amended on April 28, 2008, Applicant requests commission approval to extend its authority under Certificate No. 2203-C to include the general commodities classification on the island of Oahu.

By a notice of dismissal dated September 30, 2008, we informed Applicant of our intent to dismiss the application without prejudice because of Applicant's failure to respond to the commission's requests for information. Applicant was further advised that any objection to the dismissal of its application must be submitted in writing and filed not later than ten (10) days from the date of the notice, and that if

an objection was not filed, the commission would issue an order dismissing the application.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

Applicant did not object to the dismissal of its application within the ten (10)-day time period. We, thus, find that there is good cause to dismiss the application in this docket.

III.



THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


