DECISION AND ORDER

By this Decision and Order, the commission authorizes JERRY KIM, dba ALOHA SUPER LIMOUSINE TOUR ("Applicant"), to extend his authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1560-C ("Certificate No. 1560-C") to include the 1-to-7 passenger classification on the island of Oahu, subject to certain conditions, as described herein.

I.

Application to Extend Common Carrier Authority

Applicant is a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to utilizing motor vehicles with a maximum manufacturer's seating capacity of 15 passengers. On October 19, 2007, Applicant filed an application seeking commission approval to extend his authority under Certificate No. 1560-C to include the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

Applicant served copies of the application on the Hawaii Transportation Association and the Hawaii State Certified Common Carriers Association, Inc., which consist of carriers that may be affected by Applicant's proposed service, and on the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Consumer Advocate"). The Consumer Advocate did not participate in this proceeding, and no persons moved to intervene in this docket.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

Based upon our review of the record, we find that Applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the proposed service, and to conform to Hawaii Revised Statutes chapter 271 and the requirements and rules of the commission. We also find that the proposed service is required by the present and future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, we conclude that Applicant's request for an extension of his authority should be granted.

III.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Applicant is authorized to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the (1) 1-to-7 passenger classification, and (2) 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to utilizing

motor vehicles with a maximum manufacturer's seating capacity of 15 passengers.

2. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
