II.

Findings and Conclusions

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19(b), the commission may grant inactive status for a cumulative period not to exceed two (2) years over the life of the certificate. The commission, thus, finds good cause to deny Petitioner's request for an extension of his inactive status for a third additional year. In regard to Petitioner's alternative request to surrender his license, pursuant to HRS § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission, thus, finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. Petitioner's request that the inactive status of his Certificate No. 1258-C be extended for a third additional year is denied.


2. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1258-C is terminated, effective from March 27, 2008.


