## ORDER TERMINATING CERTIFICATE NO. 1679-C

By this Order, the commission terminates certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1679-C ("Certificate No. 1679-C"), held by SON Q. LAO ("Petitioner"), effective from the date of this Order.

I.

### Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

On March 18, 2009, Petitioner filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender his authority under Certificate No. 1679-C. Certificate No. 1679-C authorizes Petitioner to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to limousines.

II.

#### Findings and Conclusions

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public

convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.

#### Orders

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1679-C is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.
- 2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in his operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order.
- 3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, he may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.
- 4. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
