ORDER FILED ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2008

By this Order, the commission vacates the Decision and Order filed on September 16, 2008, and closes this docket.

I.

Application for Common Carrier Authority

By the Decision and Order filed on September 16, 2008, the commission approved the application of ALANA KAY, dba NA HOKULANI TOURS ("Applicant"), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Maui in the 1-to-7 passenger classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the Decision and Order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause

for the commission to vacate the Decision and Order. We served Applicant with a copy of the Decision and Order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the Decision and Order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122.

On January 12, 2009, Applicant filed a request for a sixty (60)-day extension to comply. The request was approved on January 14, 2009, which allowed Applicant until March 16, 2009 to comply.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth in the Decision and Order filed on September 16, 2008. The commission, thus, determines that the Decision and Order filed on September 16, 2008, should be vacated.


Order
