ORDER TERMINATING CERTIFICATE NO. 1713-C

By this Order, the commission terminates certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1713-C ("Certificate No. 1713-C"), held by SHINKO SENO CAMARA, dba LOCO TOURS ("Petitioner"), effective from the date of this Order.

I.

Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

On March 25, 2009, Petitioner filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender her authority under Certificate No. 1713-C. Certificate No. 1713-C authorizes Petitioner to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public

convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate her authority.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1713-C is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.


2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in her operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order.


3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, she may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.


4. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
