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Applicant Young Brothers, Limited (*Young Brothers*) and the Division of Consumer Advocacy of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (the *Consumer Advocate*) (Young Brothers and the Consumer Advocate together referred to as the *Parties*) respectfully submit to the Honorable Public Utilities Commission of the State of Hawaii (the *Commission*) this Stipulation for Amended Procedural Order (this *Stipulation*). This Stipulation is made pursuant to section 6-61-23, Hawaii Administrative Rules (*HAR*), to enlarge the period for the Parties to file a stipulation settling the issues in this proceeding, from May 14, 2009, to May 29, 2009.

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Under HAR § 6-61-23(a):

When by [HAR chapter 61] or by notice or by order of the commission, any act is required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time, the commission for good cause shown may at any time, in its discretion[, w]ith or without motion or notice, order the period enlarged, if written request is made before the expiration of the period originally prescribed or as extended by a previous order"

The deadline set by the Commission for the Parties to file their

agreement settling all of the issues in this proceeding is May 14, 2009.¹

For good cause set forth below, the Parties stipulate to enlarging the time

to file their settlement agreement, from May 14, 2009, to May 29, 2009.

In their Stipulated Motion for Evidentiary Hearing Waiver and

Enlargement of Time to File Settlement Agreement, filed on May 7, 2009,

the Parties informed the Commission that "[a]fter vigorous negotiation

discussions, the Parties have settled, in principle, all of the issues in this

rate case, including the specific determination of Young Brothers' revenue

requirement amount and specific rate design issues relating to percentage

increases for Young Brothers' lines of service, and have stipulated to waive

the evidentiary hearing scheduled for May 13 and 14, 2009, and all related

See Order Approving Proposed Stipulated Procedural Order, as Modified, filed on March 5, 2009, as amended by Order Approving the Parties' Request to Amend the Regulatory Schedule, filed on April 27, 2009 (*Procedural Order*). On May 7, 2009, the Parties filed Stipulated Motion for Evidentiary Hearing and Enlargement of Time to File Settlement Agreement, requesting, among other things, an enlargement of time to file their settlement agreement, from May 8, 2009, to May 14, 2009. By letter dated May 11, 2009, the Commission approved the new deadline of May 14, 2009, for the Parties to file their settlement agreement.

prehearing and post-hearing proceedings." Young Brothers and the Consumer Advocate, however, need more time than allowed under the deadline of May 14, 2009, to flesh out and memorialize details of the Parties' agreement, prepare work sheets in support of their agreement, and carefully cite to the record in this proceeding.²

The Consumer Advocate also asserts that additional time is necessary to coordinate communications with out-of-state witnesses, to address overlapping procedural schedules for numerous Commission dockets, and to accommodate limited staff resources.

Accordingly, the Parties stipulate to an enlargement of time to file their settlement agreement, from May 14, 2009, to Friday, May 29, 2009.
