DECISION AND ORDER

By this Decision and Order, the commission vacates the Notice of Violation, Order to Show Cause, and Notice of Hearing ("Notice"), filed on October 14, 2008, in the matter of TAMPOS TRUCKING, INC. ("Respondent").

I.

<u>History</u>

By Notice, filed on October 14, 2008, the commission ordered Respondent to appear at 465 South King Street, Room B-3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 19, 2008, to show cause why Respondent's certificate of public convenience and necessity number 2161-C should not be suspended or revoked for failure to file an annual financial report ("AFR") and pay an annual motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee") for the year 2007, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") §§ 271-25, 271-36,

and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §§ 6-62-42(a), 6-62-24(a).

On November 3, 2008, Respondent filed its 2007 AFR and paid its Fee. On November 5, 2008, the commission assessed Respondent \$2,761.39 in penalties and interest, pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i), and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b)(c) and 6-62-42(d). On December 1, 2008, Respondent submitted a proposed payment plan schedule for approval. The commission approved the plan on December 2, 2008, and on June 5, 2009, Respondent paid its last installment payment, bringing the balance owed to zero.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

The commission finds that Respondent has fully complied, although belatedly, with the motor carrier laws, rules, and regulations, and concludes that the Notice, filed on October 14, 2008, should be vacated.

III.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. The Notice, filed on October 14, 2008, is vacated.
- 2. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
