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NOTICE OF VIOLATION, ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE, AND NOTICE OF HEARING

XPRESS TRUCKING, INC. ("Respondent") is the holder of certificate of public convenience and necessity number 78-C ("Certificate"), issued pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-12.

Decision and Order No. 23862, filed on December 3, 2007, in Docket No. 2007-0159, requires that motor carriers of property or passengers reporting annual gross revenues of more than \$1 million shall file with the commission HAW-PUC Form 03-020 by June 1 for each of the calendar years, 2008 through 2011. Respondent failed to file HAW-PUC Form 03-020 for the year 2008.

HRS § 271-19 authorizes the commission, after notice and hearing, to suspend or revoke any Certificate, in part or in whole, if the commission finds that the holder violated any provision of HRS chapter 271. Accordingly, the commission may suspend or revoke Respondent's Certificate for failure to comply

with the legal requirements set forth above, unless Respondent is able to show cause why such suspension or revocation should not occur.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Respondent shall appear at 465 South King Street, Room B-3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 18, 2009, to show cause why Respondent's Certificate should not be suspended or revoked for failure to comply with the legal requirements set forth in this order.

2. Respondent may be represented by counsel. If Respondent does not retain counsel, Respondent may be represented at the hearing as follows: (a) an individual may appear on his or her own behalf; (b) a partner may represent a partnership; and (c) an officer or authorized employee of a corporation, trust, or association may represent the corporation, trust, or association.


3. If Respondent fails to appear at the scheduled hearing, Respondent's Certificate shall be suspended or revoked.
