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<sup>1</sup>In its Decision and Order filed on September 25, 2009, the commission directed the parties to submit a stipulated procedural schedule to govern the remainder of this docket. On October 12, 2009, the Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc., Hawaii Electric Light Company, Inc., and Maui Electric Company, Ltd. (collectively, "HECO Companies") and the Department Of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Division Of Consumer Advocacy filed a proposed schedule. On the same date, the Department Of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism filed its proposed schedule, in which it states that the following parties agree to DBEDT's proposed schedule: Hawaii Renewable Energy Alliance, Sopogy Inc., Clean Energy Maui LLC, Blue Planet Foundation, Tawhiri Power LLC, Hawaii Solar Energy Association, The Solar Alliance, and Zero Emissions Leasing LLC. As neither proposed schedule complies with the commission's intent for completion of this proceeding, the commission sets its own schedule.
