By this Order, the commission approves the withdrawal of the application for a certificate of authority ("COA") filed by BLC MANAGEMENT LLC, dba ANGLES COMMUNICATION SOLUTIONS ("Applicant").

#### Withdrawal Request

On October 23, 2008, Applicant filed an application ("Application") seeking commission approval for a COA to provide competitive resold and facilities-based/UNE local exchange and resold interexchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Hawaii ("State").

By letter dated September 15, 2009, and filed on September 16, 2009, Applicant requested commission approval to
