#### ORDER VACATING NOTICE OF VIOLATION

By this Order, the commission vacates the Notice of Violation, Order to Show Cause, and Notice of Hearing ("Notice"), filed on October 15, 2009, in the matter of CORAN HAULING & EXCAVATION, LLC ("Respondent").

#### History

By Notice, filed on October 15, 2009, the commission ordered Respondent to appear at 465 South King Street, Room B-3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 18, 2009, to show cause why Respondent's certificate of public convenience and necessity number 4157-C should not be suspended or revoked for failure to file an annual financial report ("AFR") and pay an annual motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee") for the year 2008, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") §§ 271-25, 271-36,

and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §§ 6-62-42(a), 6-62-24(a).

On November 16, 2009, Respondent filed its 2008 AFR, paid its Fee, and on November 17, 2009, Respondent paid \$105.96 in penalties and interest that the commission assessed, pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i), and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b)(c) and 6-62-42(d).

The commission finds that Respondent has fully complied, although belatedly, with the motor carrier laws, rules, and regulations, and concludes that the Notice, filed on October 15, 2009, should be vacated.
