Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 431:10C-410 and section 91-9.5, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Division ("Division") will hold a public hearing on Friday, April 26, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. in the Queen Kapiolani Conference Room, 2nd Floor, King Kalakaua Building, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, 335 Merchant Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, to hear all persons interested in AIPSO Filing No. HI 12-03 which was submitted by AIPSO to the Division on behalf of the Hawai'i Joint Underwriting Plan ("HJUP").

The purpose of AIPSO's filing is to provide a simplified format of the manual of rules and rates for the HJUP. The filing also combines the Personal Manual and Commercial Manual into one manual.

The proposed effective date for both new and renewal business is the first day of the sixth month following the date of approval.
