STATE APPROVES NEW OWNER FOR A HAWAI'I HURRICANE INSURER

HONOLULU – Hawai`i Insurance Commissioner J. P. Schmidt approved Universal Insurance Holdings of North America's (Universal North America) purchase of ICAT Specialty Insurance Company (ISIC).

Universal North America writes homeowners, dwelling, fire, and flood policies, and has been in the Hawai'i market since September 2008. ISIC's owner, ICAT Holdings, LLC, entered the Hawaii market in 2006 and has grown significantly providing hurricane coverage for homeowners.
