WHEREAS a Preliminary Injunction was entered by the Court on August 10, 2005;

WHEREAS some of the employees and staff of the Defendant Pacific Educational Services Company petitioned the court to permit payment of accrued salaries and other employment benefits;

WHEREAS the court reserved the matter of consideration of the employees and staff petition for further hearing on August 11, 2005 at 9:00 o'clock a.m;

WHEREAS, the matter came on for further hearing before the Honorable Sabrina S. McKenna on August 11, 2005 at 9:00 o'clock a.m.;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the

Preliminary Injunction entered on August 10, 2005 be and shall remain in full force and

effect, subject only to the modification herein:

 The Court hereby lifts the asset freeze currently in effect to permit the payment of salaries and paid time off to all employees as listed in the column titled "Currently Owed Including PTO" on Exhibit 1 hereto, excluding Hamman Hasan.

- 2. The Court hereby lifts the asset freeze currently in effect to permit the payment of the Health Benefits listed on Exhibit 1.
- 3. The Court hereby lifts the asset freeze currently in effect to permit the reissuance and payment of a check in the amount of \$3,943.09 payable to Forrest Batz.

# IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

- The Court reserves the petitioners' request to lift the asset freeze to permit payment of employee reimbursement expenses.
- 2. Employees Heather Barrie, Corrigan M. Taylor and Scott Banks be permitted to continue employment with pay in order to assist students and process transcripts only for those students requesting such and to otherwise carry out the terms of this order up to and including August 25, 2005.
- 3. The Defendants, upon written request from employees, issue letters of termination of employment to any employee so requesting.
- 4. Scott Banks is directed to return all student seat deposit monies to the students who paid them for the 2005-2006 term.
- 5. The matter be continued for further hearing on August 25, 2005 at 1:30 p.m.
