It was moved by Mr. Kaneshiro, seconded by Mr. Brady and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the February 5, 2013 Board meeting as circulated.

# Executive Officer's Report

#### a. HCC Electrical Academic Coursework Effective 7/1/2013

The Executive Officer distributed the list of non-credit courses applicants must take to qualify for any electrician classification effective July 1, 2013. The list provides the courses required for each classification and the price of each class. The cost for each classification currently is as follows:

EJ \$5,490 EJI \$4,980 EJS \$2,985 EM \$1,995

While non-credit courses are less than credited courses it is a sizeable investment for those who desire to be electricians.

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the new application will be available by July 1, 2013 and that applicants who submit their applications on or before June 30, 2013, will meet the current requirements even though they will not be licensed until after July 1, 2013. Any application filed on or after July 1, 2013 will meet the new requirements which include the education component. Any application abandoned after two years requires the applicant to reapply and meet the new requirements.

The Executive Officer requested the IBEW to please inform their members that licensees who fail to restore their licenses within the restoration period will be required to apply as a new applicant and meet the new requirements.

Deputy Attorney General Tam joined the meeting at 10:41 a.m.

The Executive Officer also informed the Board that the HCC Electrical Academic Coursework will also be posted online on the Board's Important Announcements page.

Chairperson Kimura joined the meeting at 10:43 a.m.

Chairperson Kimura announced he was taking the agenda out of order to discuss 7. Unfinished Business.

#### Unfinished Business: a. Rules Revisions

i. Local 675/PAMCA Proposal to Amend HAR §§16-80-2 and 16-80-3 (deferred from the February 5, 2013 meeting)

Mr. Serikaku requested that this issue be deferred to the next meeting.

#### Legislation: a. HB695 Relating to Electricians and Contractors

The Executive Officer informed the Board that this bill did not survive this legislative session.

## b. SB512 SD1 HD2 Relating to Electrical Contractors

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the amendment to HRS Chapter 448E-13 in section 2, will exempt employees of a licensed electrical contractor pursuant to Chapter 444, retained by a public utility to perform high voltage electrical work without an electrician's license.

The public utility will ensure that these employees are not less qualified than their own employees to perform high voltage work. These employees will also be exempt from Chapter 444-9.5, the 1 to 1 ratio. The bill also states that the exemption will end on June 30, 2018 and HRS Chapter 448E-13 will revert to its original form.

This bill will probably go to conference committee.

#### c. SB1301 SD1 Relating to Professions and Occupations

The Executive Officer reported to the Board that this bill did not survive the legislative session due to the strong opposition of many stakeholders.

Mr. Ida stated that the Plumber's Union Local 675 plans to address the jurisdictional issues with other unions and contact other stakeholders prior to the next legislative session.

The Board concurred that the unions should have dialogue with the stakeholders and the Executive Officer suggested that Mr. Ida inform the Board of the union's progress. Deputy Attorney General Tam suggested that Mr. Ida report the status of their efforts to the Board at its Board meetings.

Mr. Serikaku thanked the Board, Executive Officer and the Deputy Attorney General for their efforts in working on SB1301 during the legislative session. He iterated that the Plumber's Union still thinks licensing of the refrigeration, air conditioning and fire sprinkler technicians is a valid pursuit.

The Board Chair again asked that future proposals be brought for discussion and review prior to its introduction to the legislature.

#### Chairperson Kimura returned to the order of the agenda.
