Old Business: a. Rules Committee Report

Mr. Kobashigawa summarized the minutes of the December 13, 2012 Rules Committee meeting.

The Committee was informed about the Small Business Regulatory Review Board ("SBRRB") meeting on Monday, December 10, 2012. Besides the Board's testimony in support, there were many other testifiers (both oral and written) in support of the Board's proposed amendments to the rules. At the conclusion of the meeting, SBRRB determined that the Board's proposed amendments to the rules should proceed to a public hearing.

The Committee also discussed whether there are pending issues delegated by the Board and whether there are new issues that should be addressed by the Committee. At this time, all issues delegated by the Board have been addressed by the Committee and members did not have new issues to discuss.

b. NCARB Matters

NCARB Region 6 Meeting

This meeting is scheduled for March 14-17, 2013 in Atlanta, GA.

 Architect Registration Examination ("A.R.E.") Blackout Advisory

In July 2013, Alpine Testing Solutions, Inc. will take over content and candidate management for the A.R.E. This vendor switch will offer several enhanced services for Member Boards and candidates. Prometric, Inc. will continue to serve as the Council's site management vendor. In order to facilitate the migration of all past candidate and exam data from Prometric to Alpine, NCARB will need to enact a blackout for up to eight weeks for both Member Boards and candidates starting July 1, 2013. No exam division may be scheduled during the blackout period nor will any exam be administered during that time.

Because of the inconvenience to A.R.E. candidates, NCARB will provide a 12 week extension to each candidate's rolling clock.

CEO Update

In the December 2012 issue of the "CEO Update", it reported:

- ✓ NCARB's Council assisted AIA Honolulu with testimony to support the consideration of early eligibility to the A.R.E. in front of the SBRRB.
- ✓ The fee amnesty offer ran from October to November 2012 where a total of 842 architects and 1,541 interns took advantage of the program and reactivated their records.

 - ✓ CLARB's Spring Meeting is scheduled for March 1-2, 2013 in Scottsdale, AZ.
 - ✓ The administration dates and registration deadlines for the L.A.R.E. are as follows:

April 8-20, 2013 (registration opens on December 31, 2012 and closes on March 29, 2013)

August 19-30, 2013 (registration opens on May 13, 2013 and closes on August 9, 2013)

December 2-14, 2013 (registration opens on August 26, 2013 and closes on November 22, 2013)

• Important Notice Regarding Landscape Architectural Registration Examination ("L.A.R.E.")

Mr. Kobashigawa reported that a notice was posted to the Board's website informing of the upcoming changes regarding the L.A.R.E. exam including the requirement to establish a Council Record in order to take the exam.

d. Architect Continuing Education Audit

Review of Audits

The reviewing of architect continuing education ("CE") audits continues as more candidates are submitting their documentation.

e. Discussion on Engineer-in-Training Certificates

Mr. Kobashigawa inquired with the engineer members whether it was important and necessary to continue to issue the Engineer-in-Training certificate upon passing the FE exam as the certificate is only issued to signify that a person has passed the FE exam. The PE exam still needs to be passed before a person can get licensed. When verification of the FE exam is requested, states are only interested in whether the exam was passed or not, which negates the necessity of issuing the certificate.

After discussion, by consensus of the Board, issuing the Engineer-in-Training certificate will be discontinued after the April 2013 exam administration.

f. Results of December October 2012 Landscape Architect – Hawaii Plant Materials Exam

Correspondence: a. E-mail from Dave Wellman

Mr. Wellman a licensed land surveyor in Oregon inquired whether use of 3D laser scanning services to map archeological features into a GIS system would fall under the definition of land surveying.

It was moved by Mr. Murray, seconded by Mr. Lau, and unanimously carried that regardless of the type of technology or equipment used, if it involves the principles and practice of surveying the person doing this type of activity should be licensed as a land surveyor.

b. Letter from Chad Schlauch

Mr. Schlauch requested a waiver of the CE requirement for his architect license due to undue hardship.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Yumol, seconded by Mr. Lau, and unanimously carried to deny Mr. Schlauch's request for a waiver, but give him a one month extension to fulfill the 16-hour CE requirement.

c. E-mail from Joaquin Belisario

Mr. Belisario requested a two year extension to continue taking the A.R.E.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Skelton, seconded by Mr. Yumol, and unanimously carried to deny Mr. Belisario's request for an extension. Accordingly, Mr. Belisario will need to take a section of the A.R.E. by February 28, 2013 or his application will be considered as being abandoned and a new application would need to be filed.
