<u>Discussion on</u> <u>Amendments</u> <u>To Chapter</u> <u>16-115, HAR,</u> Ms. Sakata requested that the third paragraph of the February 14, 2013 Rules Committee minutes be clarified by adding the following:

16-115, HAR, & Chapter 464,

HRS:

"Regarding language setting time frames to complete exams, the Committee recommended that an applicant will need to pass the FE, PE, FS, PS and state-constructed surveyor exams within five (5) years of approval. Also, an applicant shall have five (5) years from the date of passing the first section of the A.R.E. and L.A.R.E. to complete the exams. For the A.R.E., each section passed is good for five (5) years. Any section passed beyond five (5) years

has to be retaken."

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By consensus, the Committee approved the clarification.

In addition, based on an inquiry from the Hawaii County, the Committee discussed the interpretation of section 16-115-9, Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR"), and whether it needs to be amended.

Hawaii County inquired as to whether only each sheet of "design drawings" need to be stamped or does each sheet of reports, specifications, maps, surveys, and descriptions have to also be stamped.

After lengthy discussion, the Committee interpreted section 16-115-9, HAR, to mean that only each sheet of the "design drawings" need to be stamped and will recommend this to the Board. Therefore, no changes need to be made to this section.
