The Board reviewed and considered all of the records and files of Dr. Schroeder's application and information received from him as well as from other organizations. After due consideration of the information received and Dr. Schroeder's oral testimony, it was moved by Dr. Desai, seconded by Mr. Puletasi and carried by majority, with Dr. Akaka opposing and Dr. Kosasa abstaining, to deny Dr. Schroeder's application for licensure, basing its decision on the following grounds of the Hawaii Revised Statues ("HRS"), which find support in the records and files of Dr. Schroeder's application:

# Noor U. Hassan, M.D.

The Board reviewed and considered all of the records and files of Dr. Hassan's application and the information received from him as well as from other organizations.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Chin, seconded by Dr. Bintliff and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Hassan's application for licensure, basing its decision on the following grounds of the Hawaii Revised Statues ("HRS"), which find support in the records and files of Dr. Hassan's application:

Request for

Reconsideration: Peter N. Schneider, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received and the presentation made by Dr. Murai, it was moved by Dr. Sept and seconded by Dr. Chin to rescind the Board's prior denial of Dr. Schneider's application for licensure. Members Sept, Chin and Bintliff voted for the motion. Members Takanishi, Akaka, Barrickman, Cody, Desai and Puletasi voted against the motion.

Dr. Kosasa abstained. The motion did not carry.

It was moved by Dr. Desai, seconded by Chair Takanishi and carried by a majority, with Drs. Sept, Bintliff and Chin opposing and Dr. Kosasa abstaining, to deny Dr. Schneider's request for reconsideration and to affirm its decision of August 11, 2011, denying Dr. Schneider's application for medical licensure.

# The following agenda items were taken out of order.

# New Business: a. Foreign Medical Graduates

The Board reviewed an email inquiry requesting that the Board consider a rule change that would allow all those who have passed subspecialty board examinations to be eligible for a Hawaii license.

After discussion, the Board determined that it is not a Board rule that had created two pathways but a statutory enactment by the Hawaii Legislature. As such, the Board cannot waive the law or create rules that are contrary to the law.

## b. Visiting Physicians

The Board reviewed an email inquiry requesting that the rules be revised to allow physicians from Japan to perform physical examinations on atomic bomb survivors from Hiroshima and Nagasaki who are now currently residents of Hawaii.

After discussion, the Board determined that such a revision may not be done through rules revisions but must go through the legislative process.

#### c. FSMB: Update on Advocacy Issues

Chair Takanishi shared with members an update on two major priorities of FSMB's advocacy efforts: 1) Federal Trade Commission; and 2) Medical Licensure and Telemedicine.

Chair Takanishi advised that he will provide updated information on this matter at the next Board meeting when he returns from the FSMB Annual meeting.

## d. <u>Scope of Practice: Body Manipulation and Massage</u>

The Board received an inquiry from a physician who is asking whether she is able to perform body manipulation and massage under her license.

The Board's informal opinion is that if she is trained in those areas, she may perform those functions.

e. <u>David Barton, M.D.: Request for Official Board Position on Practice Standards Relating to Medical Marijuana</u>

Dr. Barton is asking the Board for its official position on practice standards relating to medical marijuana. The Board determined that it is unable to take a position with respect to the State's medical marijuana program as the program does not come under the Board's jurisdiction. Additionally, the corporate practice of medicine is also not under the Board's jurisdiction, emphasizing that the Board only has jurisdiction over individual physicians.

The Board advised Dr. Barton to contact the Narcotics Enforcement Division as the program comes under its jurisdiction.

## <u>Unfinished Business:</u> a. <u>Rules Revisions</u>

Chair Takanishi advised that he will be attending the FSMB Annual Meeting. He related that he will research the PA Committee's proposal and report back to the Board on his fact-finding mission.

With regard to deleting the 7-year time limit in which to take all Steps of the USMLE, Executive Officer Cabral asked whether the Board would like to do these revisions now rather than wait until the entire set of rules has been finalized. There was no definitive response from the Board.

#### b. <u>Possible Legislation: Mental/Physical Examination</u>

The Board reviewed proposals put forth by RICO to give the director the authority to order a licensee to undergo a mental or physical examination.

After discussion, the Board decided to support RICO's proposed legislation.
