Vice-Chairperson Sasuga announced that the agenda would be taken out of order.

Ratification

The Board members reviewed the ratification lists for motor vehicle repair dealer and motor vehicle mechanic licenses. Upon a motion by Mr. Higa, seconded by Mr. Nakamura, it was unanimously carried to ratify the lists (attached).

New Business: 2012 Legislative Session

There was discussion on the Board's legislative delegate for the 2012 legislative session. Board members briefly discussed the upcoming legislative session and the possibility that Board input may be required on bills that could impact the Board's program of work. The Board further discussed the logistics involved in convening a meeting, establishing a quorum of members, the requirement to file an agenda, etc., and the impact on the Board's ability to deliver its comments in a timely manner. Mr. Higa and Mr. Nakamura volunteered to be the Board's delegates. The Executive Officer thanked Mr. Higa and Mr. Nakamura for volunteering.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Berkey, seconded by Mr. Hirakawa, and unanimously carried to appoint Mr. Higa as the Board's representative, and that he be authorized to handle legislative matters on behalf of the Board, including being the contact person to give comment on bills, and delivering testimonies at the legislature as needed, with Mr. Nakamura as Mr. Higa's backup.

Vice-Chairperson Sasuga announced that the Board would return to the order of the agenda.

At 9:46 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Ms. Berkey, and unanimously carried to enter into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to the individual applying for licensure in accordance with Chapter 92-5(a) (1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with Chapter 92-5(a) (4), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

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#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

At 10:14 a.m., it was moved by Ms. Berkey, seconded by Mr. Nakamura, and unanimously carried to return to the Board's regular order of business.

Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters: The Chairperson called for a recess from the meeting at 10:15 a.m. to deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") Chapter 91.

Previously, the Board approved two settlement agreements in which Respondents agreed to comply with the terms of those agreements. Respondents also agreed that if they failed to comply, their licenses would be suspended for one year, without a hearing, upon RICO's filing of an affidavit that Respondents failed to comply. As a result of Respondents non-compliance, RICO filed an affidavit and the Board suspended Respondents' licenses. Respondents are now requesting reconsideration and RICO is opposing the motion.

Mr. Nelson Kinoshita, attorney for Respondents, appeared before the Board on behalf of his clients. Mr. Kinoshita briefly explained that his client does comply with the law and gives his customers the written estimate of labor and parts before doing the work. He provided the Board with additional documents, which the Board reviewed. Mr. Kinoshita stated that the Board should not suspend Respondents' licenses.

Bobbi Lum-Mew, RICO staff attorney, also appeared before the Board. Ms. Lum-Mew stated that Respondents failed to comply with the terms of the agreements, and RICO notified the Board of this failure. Ms. Lum-Mew said that RICO maintains that licensees comply with the law. Ultimately, it is up to the Board to decide on sanctions.

At 10:41 a.m., Vice-Chairperson Sasuga asked that the parties be excused from the meeting for the Board to deliberate with its Deputy Attorney General.

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At 11:10 a.m., Vice-Chairperson Sasuga resumed the meeting, at which time the parties returned to the meeting room.

After discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Higa to rescind the Board's Final Order based on additional evidence submitted at today's meeting. The motion died.

After further discussion, it was moved by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Ms. Berkey, and carried by a majority vote (Mr. Higa opposed), to deny Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration and confirm that the Board's Final Order in this matter is the decision of record.

At 11:18 a.m., the Chairperson announced that the Board would return to its regular order of business.
