<u>Call to Order</u> :	With the presence of quorum, Chairperson Chow called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

<u>Meeting</u> :	It was moved by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Mr. Hirakawa, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as circulated.

<u>Correspondence</u>: <u>February 17, 2012 Email from Marlo Duarte Regarding ASE L1</u> and L2 Classifications

Chairperson Chow invited Marlo Duarte to the table where he could address the Board. Mr. Duarte introduced Ronald Woosley who is currently training under him. Mr. Duarte stated that he has been a licensed mechanic for 10 years and has been ASE certified for 15 years. As an experienced technician, Mr. Duarte stated that he is concerned about where the industry is going. He offered assistance to the Board so that it can make improvements to keep up with the changes and lift up his profession.

He related that technicians who train under him don't see the value in getting a state license; that after they get certified by ASE, he encourages them to get their licenses, but there is no interest. He said that technicians ask why they should get a license and that they see it only as an expense.

Mr. Duarte also stated that the Board should require technicians to be certified in L1 and L2 classifications and the electrical series and that having only the A and T classifications is not enough. He added that performing certain repair work without the proper knowledge can kill someone. Therefore, requiring the additional certifications would also protect the technicians.

In acknowledging Mr. Duarte's concerns, Member Nakamura stated that changes in the industry are dramatic; however, citing to washing machines, Member Nakamura said that the changes are not isolated to their industry. He further stated that requiring all technicians to have specialized/higher ASE certifications could have a chokehold effect on the profession.

Chairperson Chow asked Mr. Duarte what he was proposing. Mr. Duarte reiterated his earlier comments. Chairperson Chow stated that the Board will agree that the consumers' safety and protection is most important. He invited Mr. Duarte to submit his ideas in writing in order to give the Board an idea of what his concerns are. There was discussion about time constraints, budget, etc. that must be considered when a new program is developed.

Mr. Duarte stated that he would submit a written proposal.

Chairperson Chow announced that the Board would return to the order of the agenda.
