Correspondence: New Nursing Program Requirements Question

The Committee reviewed an email inquiry regarding establishing a nursing program in the

state of Hawaii.

The Chair stated a private agency or individual is not allowed to establish a nursing

program in the State of Hawaii. A private university can establish a nursing school, but not

a private individual.

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The EO sited the section that states; shall be vested in the governing body of a university or community college. The question is, can a private agency or individual establish a nursing program in Hawaii.

Dr. Fleming stated, only if it is a university or college.

The Committee referred to Hawaii Administrative Rules 16-89-40 which states, "(a) Control of the new nursing program shall be vested in the governing body of a university or community college."

Nursing Schools & Hepatitis B

The Committee reviewed an email regarding information on health-related schools making enrollment decisions based on an incorrect understanding of the hepatitis B virus, resulting in discrimination.

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Prelicense Distance Learning Nursing Programs

The EO stated she is working on a draft for language pertaining to distance learning programs.

Licensure of MEPN Students

The Committee continued their discussion on the licensure of MEPN students.

The Committee recommends the issuance of a temporary license to applicants who are currently in MEPN program and allowed to sit for the NCLEX-RN. The temporary license would change to a permanent license if the student graduates with a nursing degree but would automatically terminate if the student leaves the program prior to obtaining a nursing degree.
