<u>Chair's Report:</u>	The Chair informed the members that he spoke with Kathy Apple of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing ("NCSBN") regarding NURSYS, the NCSBN databank of nurses license information from other states, and was informed that Hawaii was the only state not providing information and that he believes that it is important that Hawaii participates by providing NURSYS with such information.				
	The DAG asked how other states provide NURSYS with the licensee's social security number without compromising the confidentiality of the individual licensee and also stated that there are workload issues to consider.				
	The Chair stated that he was informed the social security number was for identification purposes and that the reporting state could "block" this information from being disseminated to other states. He also stated that NCSBN is willing to hire someone to input the information.				
	The EO stated that she is still waiting for the Office of Information Practices ("OIP") on whether we are able to release information to NURSYS and that she is working on a written agreement between the Board and NURSYS regarding the confidentiality of any information provided to NURSYS.				
	The DAG recommended that the EO send a draft of the written agreement to OIP for their consideration in addition to what was previously submitted.				
	Dr. Kula volunteered to assist the EO in this project.
