Old Business:	APRN-Rxs Prescribing Controlled Substances – Status Report by EO
	DEA Status Report by EO The EO reported that she received another email from the DEA that they have forwarded the information to their Chief Counsel for further review, however, they could not provide her with a time frame on when the review will be completed. The EO reported that she will be emailing the DEA back next week to follow up and has been emailing them every two weeks to check on the status.

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Joint Formulary Advisory Committee ("JFAC") & Exclusionary Formulary for APRN-Rxs -Report on August 24, 2011 Meeting

The EO reported that she met with the JFAC for their first meeting, which basically was to provide some of the members with the "history", their goals and responsibilities and to try to address any questions.

There were some recommendations to review "categories" of drugs to be included in the formulary, however, a majority of the members did not feel that should be included in the formulary.

The JFAC pharmacists and physician wanted more information on the APRN specialties and practice, which will be provided to them at the next scheduled meeting in late September or October. A lot of the members were not available in September.

Proposed Amendments to HAR Chapter 89 Based

The Committee discussed amendments to HAR Chapter 89 to align the administrative rules with HRS Chapter 457 due to the recent changes and also to collapse the prescriptive authority into the APRN license so that the APRN with prescriptive authority did not have to pay and be issued a separate license to prescribe.

After their review of the proposed amendments, the Committee deferred this matter to the next meeting for consideration.
