Review of Test Specs for Examination Update

The Executive Officer informed the Board that with the departure of Elizabeth Shamla from Prometric, her replacement has been working from scratch and playing catch-up.

The Board reviewed the Pest Control exam test content outlines from Prometric. The Executive Officer informed the Board that the examination specs were also forwarded to Dr. Yates for his review and that she has already reviewed the Pest Control Part I, Laws and Rules section of the exam specs. The Executive Officer questioned the use of the Mallis Handbook as a reference for BR-1 (fumigation), however was reassured by Mr. Kobashigawa that the Mallis Handbook is appropriate for pest control.

It was moved by Mr. Ono, seconded by Mr. Koide, and unanimously carried to approve the Prometric pest control test content outline and specifications.

Unfinished Business: a. Rule Revisions

The Executive Officer informed the Board that she is still working on the rules changes to HAR 16-94-17 and requests the Board look at HAR 16-94-17 regarding the number of years of experience and number of jobs required for each branch.

The Executive Officer asked Mr. Lyons to ask the Industry Improvement Standards Committee for their opinion regarding the number of years a PCO would need if applying for three

branches? The Board's current interpretation of 16-94-17 is that an applicant shall have experience of at least one year per branch. Mr. Ono also stated that there should be a limit as to the number of jobs per day. The Executive Officer advised him that the Board's position is more than five jobs in one day requires additional explanation as to the job duties performed on each job.
