# Executive Officer's Report:

# 2013 Legislature

The EO reported on HB 652 Relating to Remote Dispensing was amended in conference by extending the repeal date to 2016 and prohibiting any remote dispensing pharmacies from operating within this State except for the remote dispensing pharmacies for the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center's Nanakuli and Waianae locations. The bill is currently at the Governor's Office.

## Regulated Industries Complaints Office ("RICO") Advisory Committee

The EO asked the Board to defer this agenda item as she is still waiting for the request from RICO.

# Report from Laws & Rules Committee:

Mr. Inafuku reported that the Committee continued their discussion of the categories under the miscellaneous permit section.

The Committee decided to list all the activities that the Board has addressed in the past and to categorize the activities by "dispensing" vs. "non-dispensing" and "resident" vs. "non-resident" entities.

# HAR Title 16, Chapter 95 - Status Report

The EO reported that she will be meeting with the DAG before the next meeting.

## Open Forum:

Mr. Edwards reported on SB 655 Relating to Health. This bill allows health professionals, subject to certain requirements, to treat the partners of patients diagnosed as having certain sexually transmitted diseases by dispensing or prescribing medication to the partners without examining the partners. Mr. Edwards stated part of the bill does change Chapter 328 from the standpoint of not requiring the patients name on the prescription when the health professional prescribes for the partner of a patient.

The EO clarified what this means, should a patient be diagnosed as having a sexually transmitted disease and tells the doctor that her partner cannot or will not be seeing a doctor, his/her doctor can write a prescription for the patient for his/her partner under this expedited partner therapy bill without examining the patient or having to provide the partners' name on the prescription.

Dr. Ma asked if a pharmacist can logistically fill a prescription without a name on it.

Mr. Edwards stated a pharmacist will be allowed to fill the prescription without a name as long as it shows it was written under the expedited partner therapy law.

The EO stated she will put SB 655 Relating to Health on next month's Board meeting agenda for discussion.
