She went on to request that licensee members be available to testify at any legislative hearings during the current legislative session.

Unfinished Business: a. Hawaii Psychological Association: New Legislation

Alex Santiago and Gail Tice of the Hawaii Psychological Association ("HPA"), appeared before the Board to discuss Senate Bill No. 1219 ("SB 1219") Relating to Psychologists.

Mr. Santiago indicated that Senator Gilbert Kahele will be supporting SB 1219.

Mr. Santiago indicated that SB 1219 would establish a four-year prescriptive authority pilot program to be administered by the Board to allow participating psychologists licensed by the Board to prescribe psychotropic medications under the supervision of a licensed physician at federally qualified health centers ("FQHC").

Vice Chairperson Hashimoto advised Mr. Santiago that because members just received a copy of SB 1219 and several of its members, including its Chairperson were not in attendance at the meeting, members would discuss the bill at its meeting in February.

Executive Officer Quiogue asked Mr. Santiago when the bill will be scheduled for a hearing.

Mr. Santiago answered that a hearing has not been scheduled, but could be scheduled at any time.

Mr. Santiago indicated that the proposed measure has continually passed both the Senate and House Committees in previous legislative sessions.

Dr. Combs asked Mr. Santiago for clarification regarding Section 3. of the bill. More specifically, Dr. Comb's inquired as to whether the pilot project would be limited to the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center ("WCCHC") for the first two years only.
