FOREIGN EDUCATIONAL CREDENTIALS EVALUATION SERVICES

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes section 466-5, candidates for the Uniform CPA Examination and applicants for a Hawaii CPA license who possess educational credentials from foreign colleges or universities or other four-year educational institutions, must have these credentials (degree and/or credit hours) evaluated for equivalency to credentials from an regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher learning in the United States.

If you are utilizing educational credentials from a foreign college or university in qualifying to sit for the Uniform CPA Examination or to be granted a CPA license in the State of Hawaii, please be aware that the Board of Public Accountancy ("Board") has made a change in its policy.

Effective November 9, 2012, the Board will accept foreign educational credentials (degree and/or credits) exclusively from the following evaluation service:
