c. <u>Administrative Rule Amendments</u>

Executive Officer Taniguchi distributed copies of the amendments to the Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") chapter 16-114 relating to Real Estate Appraisers, stating changes were made to keep the HAR consistent with the Hawaii Revised Statute ("HRS") chapter 16-466K and as amendments suggested by the Appraisal SubCommittee. Mr. Taniguchi inquired with committee members if there was a de minimus level for an appraisal; Vice-Chairperson Cool replied that any opinion of value would constitute an appraisal.

Chairperson Conboy suggested the amendment for HAR 16-114-88 of the omission of "federally related" be changed to replace it with "all", as conferred with DAG Tam.

After discussion, it was moved by Vice-Chairperson Cool, seconded by Mr. Yamada, and unanimously carried to accept the amendments to HAR 16-114, as distributed by the Executive Officer with the noted change to HAR 16-114-88.

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<u>Correspondence</u>: Discussion ensued on appraisers utilized by the Regulated Industries Complaints Office ("RICO") for advisory matters on cases relating to the real estate appraisal. Chairperson Conboy commented that the list of appraisers that may be utilized by RICO is kept confidential.
