### SWAT

The public hearing for the proposed SWAT rule amendments to HAR Chapter 99 is scheduled for March 29, 2001, at 9 a.m. The notice of the public hearing was printed in the February 19, 2001 issue of MidWeek. The Commission hopes to receive support from the local Boards and the Hawaii Association of REALTORS.

Senate Bill No. 1061, the Commission's SWAT bill, may possibly be heard on Tuesday, February 27, 2001.

#### Legislative Report

Legislative Report No. 3 was distributed to the Commissioners for their information.

The Commission, Division, Department and the Hawaii Association of REALTORS have reached an agreement on the definition of "material facts" for Chapter 508D, HRS, in Senate Bill No. 169 and House Bill No. 79, H.D.1. Senate Bill No. 169 is scheduled to be heard some time next week.

Senate Bill No. 769 most likely will not be heard. Since it is a single referral bill, if it is not heard by next Friday, it will die. The Commissioners also represent the condominium community, as some currently live or have lived in condominiums, currently own or have owned condominiums, and currently are or have been members of a condominium's board of directors.
