Chapter 99, Hawaii Administrative Rules, Real Estate Brokers and Salespersons became effective on May 21, 2001. A copy of the amended rules were distributed to the Commissioners for their reference and information.

The Lieutenant Governor issued a press release on the amended rules on Monday, May 21, 2001. The amended rules have been posted on the Department's and the Commission's websites. REB staff will work with the Hawaii Association of REALTORS and the local boards in disseminating the information to the licensees.
