Program of Work, FY09:

Interactive Participation with Organizations

SEO reported that on Tuesday, December 9, 2008, he attended the Hawaii Association of REALTORS' Legislative Day where HAR went over its issues for the 2009 State Legislative Program. HAR noted 5 points in its program. The 5 points are as follows: 1) Unauthorized Practice of Law, 2) Mortgage Rescue Fraud Prevention Act, 3) Historic Preservation Act, 4) Private Transfer Fee, and 5) General Excise Tax Exemption for Affordable Housing and Health Facilities. However, during the presentation, HAR noted that they will not move forward on point 5, General Excise Tax Exemption for Affordable Housing and Health Facilities, due to the poor economic climate.

Supreme Court Rule Amendments

Chair Abrams reported that in regards to the new "practice of law" definition, HAR is working towards solidifying the exemption for real estate licensees.

Mortgage Rescue Fraud Prevention Act

A copy of the Office of Consumer Protection's proposed bill relating to Mortgage Rescue Fraud Prevention Act and Real Estate Brokers and Salespersons was distributed for the committee's information. Commissioners reviewed the

proposed legislation and were asked to submit any comments on the proposed legislation to the SEO.

SEO also notified the committee that if the committee is interested in pursuing legislation allowing criminal history background checks for either new or existing licensees this measure may be the way to accomplish it.
