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Minimum Qualification Specifications
for the Classes:

CARPET CLEANER I
CARPET CLEANER II
CARPET CLEANER SUPERVISOR

Experience Requirements:

Applicants must have had the kind and quality of experience described below, and in the amounts shown in the following table:

Class Title	Specialized Experience	Supervisory Experience	Total Experience
Carpet Cleaner I	0	0	0

Carpet Cleaner Supvr	1	1	2

Specialized Experience: Experience performing cleaning and maintenance work on carpets. This experience must have provided knowledge of the operation of various carpet cleaning machines and use of related cleaning chemicals and solutions.

Supervisory Experience: *For Carpet Cleaner II, applicants must have demonstrated evidence of supervisory aptitude. Supervisory aptitude is the demonstration of aptitude or potential for the performance of supervisory duties through successful completion of regular or special assignments which involve some supervisory responsibilities or aspects; by detail to supervisory positions; by completion of training courses in supervision accompanied by application of supervisory skills in assignments; or by favorable appraisals of a supervisor indicating the possession of supervisory potential.

For Carpet Cleaner Supervisor, applicants must possess one year of experience which included the responsibility for scheduling and inspecting the work of subordinates; instructing employees in the proper methods of performing the work; maintaining discipline; insuring that safety practices are adhered to; and keeping records of work activities.

Quality of Experience: Possession of the required amount of experience will not in itself be accepted as proof of qualification for a position. The applicants' overall experience must have been of such scope and responsibility as to conclusively demonstrate that he has the ability to perform the duties of the position for which he is being considered.

Tests:

Applicants must qualify on the appropriate examination. The examination may be waived for non-competitive movements.

Physical Requirements:

Applicants must be physically able to perform efficiently the duties of the position, which are described elsewhere in this specification. Good distant vision in one eye and ability to read without strain printed material the size of typewritten characters are required, glasses permitted. Ability to hear the conversational voice, with or without a hearing aid, is required. For most positions, applicants with an amputation of arm, hand, leg or foot will not qualify for appointment; however, there may be a few positions suitable for persons with such handicaps. For most positions, applicants must be able to lift and carry objects weighing over 45 pounds. Any physical condition which would cause the applicant to be a hazard to himself or to others will disqualify for appointment. In addition, applicants must possess emotional and mental stability.

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This is an amendment to the minimum qualification specification for CARPET CLEANER I, CARPET CLEANER II, and CARPET CLEANER SUPERVISOR previously approved on December 18, 1969.
