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Minimum Qualification Specifications
for the Class:

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I, II and III

Experience and Training Requirement

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I - One (1) year of work experience involving the operation of at least two of the motorized equipment representative of the class Equipment Operator I (e.g., Farmall tractors and trucks having a factory rated capacity of less than 1-1/2 tons), or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II - One (1) year of work experience involving the operation of at least two of the motorized equipment representative of the class Equipment Operator II (e.g., trucks having a factory rated capacity of 1-1/2 but less than 5 tons, and rollers under 5 tons), or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR III - One (1) year of work experience involving the operation of at least two of the motorized equipment representative of the class Equipment Operator III (e.g., heavy motorized equipment such as trucks having a factory rated capacity of 5 tons or over, rollers of 5 tons or over, loaders, and tractors such as D-4, TD-6 and TD-9 with bulldozer blade attachments), or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

Quality of Experience

Possession of the required number of years of experience will not in itself be accepted as proof of qualification for a position. The applicant's overall experience must have been of such scope and level of responsibility as to conclusively demonstrate that he/she has the ability to perform the duties of the position for which he/she is being considered.

License Required

Applicants must possess a valid license to drive in the State of Hawaii, and a valid Commercial Driver's License of the appropriate type, as applicable.

Selective Certification

Specialized knowledge, skills and abilities may be required to perform the duties of some positions. For such positions, Selective Certification Requirements may be established and certification may be restricted to eligibles who possess the pertinent experience and/or training required to perform the duties of the position.

Agencies requesting selective certification must show the connection between the kind of training and/or experience on which they wish to base selective certification and the duties of the position to be filled.

Tests

Applicants may be required to qualify on an appropriate examination.

Physical and Medical Requirements

Applicants must be able to perform the essential duties and responsibilities of the position effectively and safely, with or without reasonable accommodation.

This is an amendment to the minimum qualification specifications for the classes EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I, II, and III, which were approved on April 25, 1991.
