## REPORT ON THE ENROLLMENT STATUS OF CHILDREN IN THE STATE CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM PURSUANT TO ACT 158, SECTION 4, PARAGRAPH (19), SESSIONS LAW OF HAWAII 2008

Act 158, Section 4, Paragraph (19), Sessions Law of Hawaii (SLH) 2008, amends Act 213, Part III, SLH 2007, by adding a new Section 62.2 that requires the Department of Human Services to prepare a report that shall include, but not be limited to: 1) the total number of enrolled children in the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP); 2) the total number of enrolled children below and over 250% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL); and 3) the total number of enrolled children 0 to 5, 6 to 12, and 13 to 19 years of age, categorized into the below and over 250% FPL groups.

The following Table provides an average of SCHIP enrollment for months January-September 2008.
