**REPORT ON THE ENROLLMENT STATUS OF CHILDREN IN THE STATE
CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM PURSUANT TO ACT 158,
SECTION 4, PARAGRAPH (19), SESSIONS LAW OF HAWAII 2008**

Act 158, Section 4, Paragraph (19), Sessions Law of Hawaii (SLH) 2008, amends Act 213, Part III, SLH 2007, by adding a new Section 62.2 that requires the Department of Human Services to prepare a report that shall include, but not be limited to: 1) the total number of enrolled children in the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP); 2) the total number of enrolled children below and over 250% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL); and 3) the total number of enrolled children 0 to 5, 6 to 12, and 13 to 19 years of age, categorized into the below and over 250% FPL groups.

The following Table provides an average of SCHIP enrollment for months January-September 2008.
