The Commission on Water Resource Management (Commission) will conduct a limited meeting and site visit to the Wai'ale'ale (Blue Hole, North Fork Wailua) and Waikoko stream diversion structures on the 'Ili'ili'ula-North Wailua Ditch and the Upper and Lower Waiahi Hydropower Plants operated and maintained by the Kaua'i Island Utility Cooperative in Wailua, Kaua'i, Hawai'i

The August 20, 2018 limited meeting and site visit locations and times are outlined below. This limited meeting is necessary to aid the Commission in decision-making on the proposed interim instream flow standards for Wai'ale'ale and Waikoko streams, Wailua surface water hydrologic unit. Public attendance is not practicable and no public testimony regarding the site visit will be taken. Hazardous road conditions will require four-wheel drive vehicles and accessibility is dependent upon weather and road conditions. The site visit will be recorded on video and the video will be made publicly accessible on the Commission website following this meeting and will be made available at the Commission's next regular meeting.
