Aloha Kaleo,

In the past, petitioners have routinely waived the requirement that their petitions be acted upon within 180 days. *See e.g.* HRS 174C-71(2)(E) and HAR 13-169-41; *Nā Moku v. Thielen*, No. 28970 (Hawaii 2/19/2008) (Haw. 2008) and *In Re Water Use Permit Applications*, 94 Hawaiii 97, 152, 9 P.3d 409, 464 (2000). The Commission on Water Resource Management took 17 years to resolve the petitions that Nā Moku Aupuni O Koʻolau Hui filed. For the record, the Sierra Club is not waiving that requirement; it expects a decision on its petition to be rendered within 180 days of its filing; and objects to an extension of time.

A decision within 180 days is imperative. These streams have been deprived of all their baseflow for far too long. BLNR has accepted the final environmental impact statement for A&B's proposed lease of state lands to divert water from these streams. Given that BLNR will be deliberating on the issuance of a lease shortly, real interim inflow standards for these streams must be established expeditiously.

We believe that the Commission can grant the petition within 180 days given that Dr. Strauch has already begun visiting these streams and collecting data and that draft IFSARs have been

prepared for these streams. Dr. Parham's study in the A&B's FEIS provides additional data and highlights the devastating impact that these diversions have on these twelve streams.

Please keep us informed as to the status of the petition. Mahalo.
