## DECLARATION OF LUCIENNE DE NAIE

I, Lucienne de Naie, under penalty of perjury hereby state the following is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge and belief:

- 1. The statements below are based upon my personal knowledge.
- 2. I live on, and am a resident of, Maui. And have been so for decades.
- 3. I have been a member of the Sierra Club for decades.
- 4. I live in Huelo not far from Hanehoi and Waipio Iki Streams.
- 5. I have served in various roles in the Sierra Club Hawai'i chapter and the Maui Group, including as a hike leader.
  - 6. I have hiked to or along many east Maui streams as a part of Sierra Club outings.
- 7. I have also hiked to or along many east Maui streams as an individual or with friends (i.e. not part of an official Sierra Club outing).

- 8. I plan to continue to visit many of the east Maui streams this year and in future years.
- 9. I have hiked to or along the following streams in east Maui: Honopou, Hoolawa ili'ili, Hoolawa nui, Honokala, Mokupapa, Waipio, Waipioiki/Kapalaea, Puolua, Hanehoi, West Hanehoi, Huelo, Hoalua, Hanawana, Kailua, Nailiilihaele, Puehu, Oopuola, Ka'aiea, Kolea, Waiakamoi, Waihinepe'e, Puohakamoa, Haipuaena, Punalau, Honomanu, Nua'ailua, Piina'au, Waiokamilo, Wailuanui, West Wailua iki, East Wailuaiki, Kopiliula, Waiohue, Paakea, Waiakea, Kapaula, Hanawi and Makapipi.
- 10. In 2018, I submitted written testimony and testified in person to the BLNR on the continuation of the revocable permits. One of the points I made was that it did not appear that A&B and EMI had cleaned up the trash that litters public land. The Sierra Club submitted photographs to DLNR showing some of the old pipes and debris.
- 11. On February 25, 26 and 27, 2020 I went on a site visit of east Maui streams with EMI's manager Mark Vaught, the Sierra Club's expert Michael Kido, the Sierra Club's attorney David Kimo Frankel, as well as other Sierra Club members.
- 12. Attached as Exhibit 103 is a photograph I took on or about February 25, 2020 that shows an old, abandoned, rusty pipe next to, and over, Hoʻolawa Stream near intake W-20. The photograph fairly and accurately depicts what I saw that day.
- 13. Attached as Exhibit 104 is a photograph I took on or about February 25, 2020 that shows an old abandoned pipe in Hoalua Stream. The photograph fairly and accurately depicts what I saw that day.
- 14. Attached as Exhibit 105 is a photograph I took on or about February 25, 2020 showing some of the metal pieces littering the ground in and near the dry streambed of

Hoolawanui Stream. The photograph fairly and accurately depicts what I saw that day.

15. Attached as Exhibit 106 is a photograph I took on or about February 25, 2020 that shows an old, abandoned pipe next to Hoʻolawa Stream near intake W-20. The photograph fairly and accurately depicts what I saw that day.
