MINUTES:

REQUEST OF COUNTY OF HAWAII FOR SET ASIDE OF LAND FOR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FIELD, KEALAKEHE, NO. KONA,

ITEM F-2 HAWA

Inasmuch as the area in question is in conflict with the State Housing Financing and Development Corporation's plans for the Kealakehe Housing Project and because of Hawaii County's deadline for EPA funding, Mr. Shimabukuro asked that this item be deferred to the October 14, 1988 meeting.

ACTION Deferred.

REQUEST FOR AN AMENDMENT TO CDUA OA-487A FOR AN ADDITIONAL GENERATOR AND AUXILIARY EQUIPMENT AT HELCO'S GENERATING STATION AT KEAHOLE, NORTH KONA, HAWAII - AGENT: DHM PLANNERS, INC.; APPLICANT: HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC LIGHT CO.

Rather than a diesel generator, Mr. Evans said that Hawaiian Electric is requesting approval to use an electric turbine generator. The last time the board approved an amendment the question was raised to the applicant as to how many more generators would be required on the site. The intent was for the applicant to take advantage of the potential geothermal development that was expected to be coming in the future. The applicant, at that time, did indicate that they were going to pursue the idea of making full use of the geothermal that was to be developed. However, between that board approval and those representations, geothermal development today has not really progressed at the same speed that the population increased in density and need has progressed. Accordingly, staff is recommending approval of this request.

Mr. Kealoha noted that staff's recommendation did not indicate the type of generator that would be used and said that he would feel more comfortable if this was shown in the recommendation. Mr. Evans said that there would be no problem amending the recommendation to show that an electric turbine would be used.

Relative to Condition No. 1, that the noise level be monitored at the property line and that additional noise abatement measures be provided, Mr. Paty asked if staff had a specific abatement measure in mind if it should exceed 70 dBA. Mr. Evans said that the noise study which was done on this indicated that under the worse case scenerio, that 70dBA noise level would be exceeded in the southern portion of the property line. The study pointed out that if you put on new mufflers that should alleviate even the worse case conditions. Notwithstanding that, staff felt that they should have an opportunity, if complaints come in and it turns out that the problem is that it is going above 70dBA, that staff have some flexibility of forcing them to do something else.

Mr. Paty asked, "if it turns out that whatever measures currently being planned are not adequate to hold the noise level at an acceptable point what then would the mitigating measure be?" Mr. Evans said that they use a term "GEP", which means good engineering practices. This is where they go back and look to see what they can do, on an engineering basis, to reduce the noise.

Mr. Paty asked the same question of the applicant. Mr. Clyde Nagata, representing the applicant, said that they intend to monitor the noise level after installation of the new generator and if it should exceed the noise level then they are looking at other options i.e. earth berm barrier around the facility. Mr. Paty then asked, "you would be prepared to

undertake those measures if the board is able to show that this noise level is not being met?" Mr. Paty was trying to determine what would need to be done for the applicant to say that they are willing to spend this extra money to put up a hollow tile barrier or whatever is needed to deal with the noise level. Mr. Nagata said that if their monitoring does show that they are exceeding the noise level then they will come back to the board with plans to do the mitigation work.

As he understood the noise code, Mr. Ing said that he thought that this was measured at the point of the closest residence, rather than the property line itself. He asked if, in the analysis, this was ever taken into consideration. Mr. Nagata said that, basically, there is no noise code for the Big Island. However, in trying to comply with what was required of them, basically the concern, in a worst-case basis, would be at the property line. If they are able to maintain this at the property line then the noise at the residences would be much less.

Mr. Ing said that when they went through the geothermal proceedings they did talk in great detail about the noise levels so he wondered where they got those standards from. In reply, Mr. Evans said approved an earlier application for this particular request, the board request, the board, as There is no noise code for the Big Island so staff came to the board with a figure of 70 dBA, which was issued by the City and County of Honolulu.

While recognizing the problems, Mr. Kealoha felt also that the board would have to look at other terms and conditions, which could be worked out with the applicant. He expressed concerns for those people living within the ag park area.

Mr. Paty asked what the difference in the current noise level would be as opposed to the noise level anticipated with the new generator. Mr. Nagata felt that the level would only be raised by 1 dBA with the new generator.

ACTION

Mr. Arata moved to approve as submitted by staff and also to add a new condition with respect to monitoring. Motion carried unanimously with a second by Mr. Kealoha.

ITEM H-6

CDUA FOR FENCING TO CONTROL ILLEGAL PARKING, "FOR PROTECTION OF DESIRED VEGETATION... (AND FOR) EROSION CONTROL" - FILED BY DIANE G. FAYE.

Mr. Evans said that the applicant proposes to protect the subject parcel from illegal parking by trespassers, which (parking) is in violation of the Administrative Rules of the Department and HRS, Chapter 183, Section 41, by constructing a fence 3'6" in height, with supporting fence posts.

While recommending approval, Mr. Evans said that staff is concerned with the use of barbed wire as fencing material. Therefore, Condition No. 8 says that the applicant is authorized to use (subject to Condition No. 5) only such fencing material (not barbed wire), will be acceptable to DLNR and the Kauai Planning Department.

As long as they are in compliance with the County Ordinance, Mr. Kealoha did not feel that we should be concerned with the type of fencing material they use. Mr. Evans said that staff was just trying to address concerns which they have received. Kauai County, for instance, had asked that they don't use barbed wire.

Ms. Diane Faye, one of the landowners, said that her family has owned this property for more than fifteen years and, years ago, had no problems requiring a fence. However, in recent years, with the growth of commercial activities in the area, there has been a growing problem of people using their private property as though it's a public park. Trash is everywhere and people are relieving themselves without regard to decency or privacy.

Ms. Faye said that they would like to use their property and the only way to do this is by building a fence to keep the people and cars off.

ACTION Mr. Apaka moved to approve with an amendment to the conditions that there will be no restriction as to the type of fencing to be Mr. Kealoha, motion carried unanimously.
