REMARKS:

Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Board on September 28, 2001 (D-4), right-of-entry permits were issued for beach activities in the past.

After discussion about different types of commercial activities and any associated requirements, staff brings the request to the Board for disposition. The form of disposition could be in form of a revocable permit.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

No comments were solicited from government or community agencies.

The ATC Makena Services LLC, is requesting a one-day permit for the blessing and dedication of a Hawaiian sailing canoe. The canoe was crafted in the town of Lahaina on the island of Maui and is being dedicated to the resort in appreciation of their contributions and support of the canoe building program. The ceremony is scheduled for January 18, 2012 from 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm. Set-up will be at 3:00 pm and break down by 11:00 pm.

The proposed activity is of a similar type and scope of beach activities that periodically occurred and continues to occur on this and other beach areas across the State. Such activities have resulted in no known significant impacts, whether immediate or cumulative, to the natural, environmental and/or cultural resources in the area. As such staff believes that the proposed event/use would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously existing.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board

- 1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
- 2. Authorize the issuance of a revocable permit to the ATC Makena Services LLC, covering the subject area for the blessing and dedication of a Hawaiian sailing canoe ceremony purposes under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
 - A. The standard terms and conditions of the most current revocable permit form, as may be amended from time to time;
 - B. No possession or consumption of alcohol within the shoreline area;
 - C. Review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General; and
 - D. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.
