# CHARACTER OF USE:

Film Projection and Viewing Tent

### TERM:

This is a five-day event, commencing on June 13, 2012 at 8:00 a.m. through June 17, 2012 at 11:00 p.m.

#### RENTAL:

Payment of \$840.00 rental fee. (Rental fee based on \$.10 per square foot per day; 1,680 square feet x \$.10 = \$168.00 per day x 5 days = \$840.00).

#### **CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:**

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(a)(1)(4) the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 4, that exempts activities, which involve "Minor alteration in the conditions of land, water, or vegetation." Staff consulted the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands and was advised that they had no objection to the proposed activities due to the temporary and minimally intrusive nature of the activities.

# **REMARKS**:

Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Board on September 28, 2001 (D-4), right-of-entry permits were issued for these types of beach activities (film projection and viewing) in the past. This annual event has taken place at Wailea Beach for the past 12 years.

After discussion about different types of commercial activities and any associated requirements, staff brings the request to the Board for disposition. The form of disposition should be in form of a Right-of-Entry permit.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

No comments were solicited from government or community agencies.

Ms. Jeanine Thomason is requesting a right-of-entry permit for The Maui Film Festival at Wailea, to utilize a portion of Wailea Beach for the five-day film-viewing event. A large viewing screen and a 15'x 15' projection tent will be set up within an 24' wide x 70' in length (1,680 sq. ft) area for exclusive use on Wailea beach. There will be no seating or placement of chairs within the subject area. The film festival is scheduled for the dates of June 13, 2012, through June 17, 2012. For the duration of the permit the projection tent will remain, inclusive of the poles for the large viewing screen. Daily set up will start at approximately 4:00 p.m. The event will take place from 8:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m. On June 17, 2012, the event including clean up, will be completed at approximately 11:00 p.m.

There are no other pertinent issues or concerns. Staff has no objections to this request.

# RECOMMENDATION: That the Board:

- 1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
- 2. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Jeanine Thomason (Event Manager) for the annual Maui Film Festival at Wailea, covering the subject area for film viewing purposes under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
  - a. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time;
  - b. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.
