REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES CHAIRPERSON TO ENTER INTO A FEDERALLY FUNDED CONTRACT (\$387,000) BETWEEN DLNR AND PIONEER MACHINERY, INC. FOR THE CASTING/MANUFACTURING AND DELIVERY OF ARTIFICIAL REEF HABITATS

Submitted for your consideration and approval is a request to enter into a Contract with Pioneer Machinery, Inc. for an initial twelve (12) month period with three (3) options to extend for additional twelve (12) month periods. The federally funded Contract uses funds from a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Sport Fish Restoration grant awarded to the Department's Division of Aquatic Resources. No State funds are being used. Pioneer Machinery was the lowest and responsible bidder at \$387,000.00, reference IFB DAR-2012-002, Pursuant to HRS 103D 302, which closed on May 31, 2012.

This project consists of the construction and delivery of the artificial reef habitats to Pier 60 located at Sand Island, Oahu, or another pier as designated by the State. The concrete for this project is donated excess concrete from Ameron HC & D. Each habitat weighs about 2,500 pounds, or if deep-water prototype is designated, will weigh about 4,000 pounds each. The annual quantity is estimated at 1,800 habitats.

Attached is the copy of the Governor's approval for the expenditure of the federal funds.





Submitted herewith for your approval is a request to expend federal funds and hire contractors to build the fish shelters and to deliver them to the State's artificial reefs. Procurement of the contractors will be via the Competitive Sealed Bids (IFB) process pursuant to HRS 103D-302, HAR Chapter 3-122, Subchapter 5.

One IFB will be for the manufacturing of approximately 1500 fish shelters per year. The fish shelters are four feet (4') wide by eight feet (8') long and five inches (5") thick and weigh approximately 2500 pounds each. Each fish shelter will be reinforced with 90 linear feet of rebar. Estimated cost per fish shelter is approximately \$200; total estimated cost of \$300,000. The fish shelters are made from surplus concrete donated by the local concrete company. This donation is used as State matching funds to receive the federal funds. For each fish shelter that is purchased, the State gets a donation from Ameron Hawaii of \$93.75 (per module, .75 cu yd of concrete) for which the Division of Aquatic Resources (DAR) can get \$281.25 in federal funds. Because the concrete is free of charge, the artificial reef project uses only the federal funds in cash expenditure.

The second IFB will be for annual tug and barge for delivery to and deployment of the fish shelters at the selected site. The fish shelters will be loaded onto a barge and then towed by tug to one of the State's artificial reef locations. Prior to the deployment, DAR staff will conduct assessments of the deployment area to make sure it is devoid of sensitive and protected marine

life. Buoys will be used to frame the target deployment area so that the fish shelters do not land outside of the deployment area. The estimated cost for the tug and a barge service is \$125,000 per year.
